

Selina Brenner (*1994, Zurich) is a vocalist, performing artist, composer and improviser.

In 2019 she completed her Bachelor's studies in Jazz and Contemporary Music at the Hochschule der Künste Bern (HKB), specializing in voice. In 2022 she completed her Masters in Music Performance at the HKB, among others with Andreas Schaerer, Efrat Alony, Ronny Graupe and Dorothea Schürch.

Her musical focus lies in the poetic assembly of words and their deconstruction into lyrics, as well as song elements and their abstraction - both in a composed and improvised manner. She sees the body as a holistic instrument and finds artistic expression by incorporating movement and atypical visual elements into concert settings.

She grew up in Maryland (USA) before moving to Switzerland when she was 12 years old. This makes English her second mother tongue (along with Swiss German). Selina has been living and working in Berne since the beginning of her studies in 2016.
